



Examination Rules with effect from the Academic Year 2025-26

1. Structure of Examinations

- a. Each course shall include Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) and End Semester Examination (ESE).
- b. Weight-age: CIE (40%) and ESE (60%) unless specified otherwise.
- c. **Winter Examination:** For Odd semester Courses (Sem-1, 3, 5, 7)
- d. **Summer Examination:** For Even semester Courses (Sem-2, 4, 6, 8)

2. Examination Components

2.1 Continuous Internal Evaluation (C.I.E.)

a. For Theory Head Courses (40Marks)

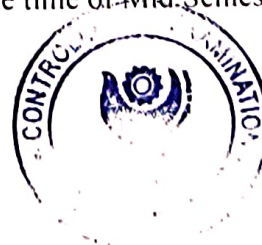

2.1.1 The following guidelines are followed for the Semester In (Continuous) evaluation.

- i. The process of evaluation is continuous throughout the semester as following Table:

- ii. Mid Semester Exam will be conducted for 20 Marks; No Re-Exam will be there for Mid Semester Exam but following Special Cases can be considered as stated bellow:
 - a. The Student met an accident and gets hospitalized for more than 3 days at the time of Mid Semester Exam and documents should be submitted immediately.
 - b. If the student is representing College/DBATU at state/National Level with proper approval.
 - c. If the Students Mother / Father get expired at the time of Mid Semester Exam.

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2.2 End Semester Examination (E.S.E.)

2.2.1 For Theory Head Courses (Total Marks: 60 Marks)

- Comprehensive examination covering the entire syllabus.
- Duration: Regular Courses – 03 hours, Drawing Courses-04 hours
- Pattern: No. of questions - 05, Each one on EACH UNIT of 12 marks with different Levels
- Optional Marks - 50% (30 Marks) (Solve Any 2 out of 3)
- In case of physically disabled examinee, who can write but at much slower speed as compared to normal student, he/she may be allowed an extra time (at most 10 minutes per hour) for writing the examination for all the courses, provided he/she seeks permission from Principal/Director for extra writing time on account of his/her disability ONLY after producing percentage of disability certificate from Civil Surgeon / M. D. specialized Doctor to this effect.
- Reporting Time for End Semester Examination Hall**
 - Student should report to the examination hall 30 mins. before the start of exam.
 - Students will not be allowed in the examination hall after the above said time.
 - Students will not be allowed in the examination hall without Hall Ticket, Uniform and College ID Card.

2.2.2 For Lab Head Courses (Total Marks As per Structure)

Internal Oral/Practical Examination:	60% Marks
External Oral/Practical Examination:	40% Marks
Total→	100% Marks

2.2.3 Passing Criteria

1. Theory Head of 100 Marks (CIE40M+ESE60M)

For Theory Head, out of 100 Marks, student should get minimum 40 Marks for passing, out of which he/she must score minimum 24 Marks out of 60 Marks in ESE.

2. Lab Head of 50 Marks (CIE30M+ESE20M)

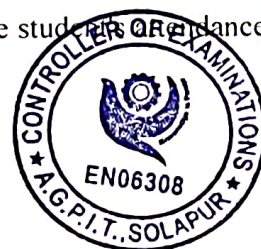
For Lab Head, out of 50 Marks, student should get minimum 20 Marks for passing, out of which he/she must score minimum 08 Marks out of 20 Marks in ESE.

3. Lab Head of 100 Marks (CIE60M+ESE40M)

For Lab Head, out of 100 Marks, student should get minimum 40 Marks for passing, out of which he/she must score minimum 16 Marks out of 40 Marks in ESE.

2.2.4 Criteria to qualify/eligible for End Semester Examination for Theory Head, if and only if:

- Attendance calculation for Lecture/Tutorial/Practical/Skill (LTPS): Attendance of a student on a course is calculated based on the credit-weighted average of the student's attendance in





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each of the LTPS components of the course.

- b. Attendance start date: Attendance is counted from the class commencement date. However, for transferred or newly admitted students, attendance in their admitted semester is counted from the date of admission.
- c. Attendance requirements:
 - i. Minimum Attendance: 85% attendance is required for course promotion and appearing for the semester-end exam.
 - ii. Condonation: Up to 10% condonation by Principal is possible for medical emergencies with proper documentation submitted within a week. Students will be levied a condonation fee to appear for the semester-end exam.
 - iii. Marginal Cases: Attendance slightly below 75% due to severe medical or valid reasons may be considered for further relaxation by the condonation board appointed and headed by the Academic/Management Council.

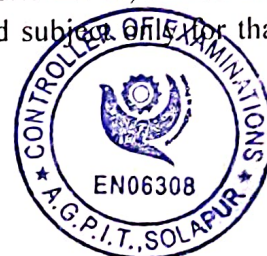

- a. Grading shall follow the Grading Table as given in following table

3. Grace Marks Rule: Total Grace Marks shall be Maximum up to 1% of total End semester scheme marks

- a. Ordinance 1: Combination of 1% of total semester scheme marks are applicable to a maximum of 2 Marks for courses (Maximum 3 courses) in those failed subject only for that semester.
- b. Ordinance 2:
 - i) If student is failed in ONLY ONE Subject and he/she has passed in ALL Remaining subjects (Without Grace) of that Regular semester Exam, he/she can get Grace Marks as Maximum up to 5 marks in that failed subject for that semester.





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ii) If student is failed in **ONLY TWO** Subject and he/she has passed in **ALL Remaining subjects (Without Grace)** of that Regular semester Exam, he/she can get **Grace Marks** as **Maximum 6 marks (Sum of Grace of TWO Subjects)** in those failed subject only for that semester.

c. Ordinance 3:

- i. Award of **Total 10 grace marks (Per Academic Year)** can be given to the students for participation in **Sports (Inter-University Level or State/National/International Level)** and completed the scheme satisfactorily with certification for Regular End Semester Examination.
- ii. **2% of TOTAL Marks in each semester** may be awarded only for acquiring 'EE' grade for **Physically Handicapped students**.

4. Examination Other than End Semester Examination

- a. **Makeup Examination for Absent Students due to following reasons:** If the Student is absent for ESE (Go for Make-up Examination) in any semester with prior permission of Higher Authorities (in written format) due to
- i. Official participation in International/National Levels sports
 - ii. Official participation in NSS in other Institute
 - iii. Some Medical/Accidental issues (with Medical Certificate from M.D. Doctor only),
 - iv. Death in blood relation (Father, Mother, siblings)

Then he/she is eligible for **another immediate examination** after regular students' examination in discussion with respective **HOD** and **COE** after providing concerned valid official documents.

b. Remedial Examination only for acquiring 'EE' grade.

- i. If students fail in some Courses (Subjects), he /she can appear for Remedial Examination which shall be conducted immediately after 15-20 days of Regular Examination result declaration.
- ii. Students must fill separate examination form for Remedial Examination by submitting Examination Fees as per rules.
- iii. Format of Remedial examination is same as End Semester Examination and passing criteria will be 24 marks out of 60 marks.
- iv. No Revaluation and Photocopy will be accepted.

c. Supplementary/ Backlog Examination

- i. If students fail in some Courses (Subjects) in Remedial Examination, he /she can appear for Supplementary/ Backlog Examination which shall be conducted along with End Semester Examination.
- ii. If a student passes in some Courses (Subjects) in Remedial Examination, he /she can appear for Supplementary/ Backlog Examination for improvement of his grade/Result.





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5. Class Promotion Rules: There is no restriction for promotion from odd semester to even semester.

a. Promotion from First Year to Second Year B.Tech (S.Y. B.Tech.):

However, at the end of the first year, for promotion to 2nd year (i.e. 3rd semester), a student should have completed satisfactorily at least 60 % of the total credits in 1st and 2nd semesters put together.

b. Promotion from Second Year to Third Year B.Tech (T.Y. B.Tech.)

- i. **For First Year Students:** However, at the end of the second year, for promotion to 3rd year (i.e. 5th semester), a student should have completed satisfactorily at least 70 % of the total credits in 3rd and 4th semesters put together, and student should have cleared all the course work requirements of the first year (i.e. 1st and 2nd semester).
- ii. **Direct Second Year (DSY) Students:** However, at the end of the second year, for promotion to 3rd year (i.e. 5th semester), a student should have completed satisfactorily at least 60 % of the total credits in 3rd and 4th semesters put together.

c. Promotion from Third Year to Final Year B.Tech.

- i. **For First Year Students:** For promotion from the third year to final year (i.e. 7th semester) a student should have completed satisfactorily at least 80 % of the total credits in 5th and 6th semesters put together (even after re examination), and student should have cleared all the course work requirements of the first and second years.
- ii. **Direct Second Year (DSY) Students:** For promotion from the third year to final year (i.e. 7th semester) a student should have completed satisfactorily at least 75% of the total credits in 5th and 6th semesters put together (even after re-examination), and student should have cleared all the course work requirements of the first and second years.

6. Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) & Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

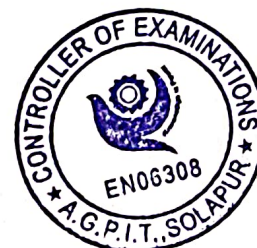
a. SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average):

$$SGPA = \frac{[\sum_{i=1}^n C_i g_i]}{[\sum_{i=1}^n C_i]}$$

Where, 'n' is the number of subjects for the semester,

'C_i' is the number of credits allotted to a particular subject, and

'g_i' is the grade-points awarded to the student for the subject based on his performance as per the above table.





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SGPA will be rounded off to the second place of decimal and recorded as such.

b. CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average):

$$CGPA = \frac{[\sum_{i=1}^m C_i g_i]}{[\sum_{i=1}^m C_i]}$$

'm' is the total number of subjects from the first semester onwards up to and including the semester,

'C_i' is the number of credits allotted to a particular subject, and

'g_i' is the grade-points awarded to the student for the subject based on his/her performance as per the above table.

CGPA will be rounded off to the second place of decimal and recorded as such.

7. Award of Degree for all UG Programs (Minimum CGPA ≥ 5.00)

- a. Class will be awarded based on CGPA for all Eight semesters (for First Year to Last Year students) and for Last Six Semesters (for Direct Second Year Admitted students)

Class	CGPA
Distinction	≥ 7.50
First Class	6.50 ≤ CGPA ≤ 7.49
Second Class	5.50 ≤ CGPA ≤ 6.49
Pass Class	5.00 ≤ CGPA ≤ 5.49

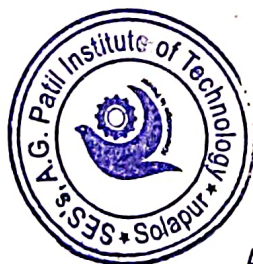
- b. If a minimum CGPA criterion is not fulfilled, then student should reattempt pass course /courses for Improvement (Maximum 2 Theory Heads within one year after the declaration of result of that year)

8. A student may be declared "Not Fit for Technical Education" (NFTE) if they fail to meet certain academic milestones, such as

- Eligibility:** A student is declared NFTE if they are unable to get eligibility for the third semester after three academic years from their admission date.
- Backlogs:** Failing to clear all back papers within eight years of admission.
- Degree Completion:** If a student cannot complete their B. Tech degree within eight years.
- Exams:** Not passing a required exam after more than three attempts.

Note: The Norms/Rules/Amendments declared/announced by DBATU/State Government/DTE/AICTE/UGC from time to time will be followed and amended in the rules as per requirement.
